Traffic flow the amount of lorries that are expected to go around the A18 roundabout is of great concern as the area is not wide enough causing significant safety concerns. This has not been resolved by the alterations proposed.

The Parish Council are also concerned that the plans have changed significantly since the original proposal and there is no reassurance to the parishioners of Barnetby le Wold, that there will be no additional water added to Barnetby le Wold water drainage system causing more flooding issues.
