	e) The Internal Audit actions regarding the website were discussed and a response received form Kyanite: “Barnetby PC website has an accessibility statements, however, from the audit documents you've sent it is just that they haven't been updated to reflect the changes between WCAG2.1 and WCAG 2.2. Since these websites are currently compliant with our understanding of the WCAG 2.1. and there seem to be no updates included in WCAG 2.2 which apply to them, I can just update the accessibility statement. You should be aware that our original caveat (from when the site was initially assessed for WCAG 2.1) still applies i.e. we are not specialists in WCAG but the "disproportionate burden" clause of the compliance guidelines probably applies to your parish council as the website is small and relatively simple so the cost of engaging a specialist consultancy wouldn't make sense as it would likely be very expensive.”
